Dear Parents:

It is with great enthusiasm that I write regarding our Sunday School Program for the 2009-2010 academic year.

As you know, Sunday School and regular church attendance play a very important role in our children's spiritual development. In that regard, we have made the following progress to the schedule in order to accommodate students, parents and teachers and to have all of you at the Divine Liturgy as early as possible.

PLEASE PAY THE PROPER ATTENTION TO THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:

*Sunday School children will come early to the Church with their parents and will sit in the middle front pews with their teachers.

*At about 10:20am right after the reading of the Divine Liturgy Gospel the priest will talk to the children for a few (7-10) minutes.

*After Holy Communion all children including the Altar Boys will go to their Sunday School classes.

*The lesson will be finished at 11:45am and we ask the parents of Pre-K and Kindergarten to take their children from classes no earlier than 11:45am.

*Altar Boys who serve every third Sunday must be in the Holy Altar dressed in their robes before 10:00am.

Our Sunday School is open to all the children of our community ages 4 through 18. The teachers are ready to teach their students with texts and appropriate materials approved by our Archdiocese.

The rules of the Archdiocese and the Connecticut Eastern Orthodox Basketball and Volleyball League, will be enforced.

Registration will take place on Sunday, September 6, 2009 during coffee hour. With your continued support and cooperation we look forward to a very successful and exciting year!
